

# From early childhood curiosity to early school leaving

# Compulsory Education Giving all young people a future

Tuesday 13 - Thursday 15 May 2008, Brussels

This Colloquium addresses one of the five benchmarks of the EU "Education and Training 2010" work program, namely the problem of early school leavers. One in six young people in the 27 countries of the European Union leaves school with no more than lower secondary education and does not participate in any kind of education or training after this point.<sup>1</sup>

This statistic suggests that those young people have somehow lost interest in learning or at least in formal learning. At the same time it is known that children are born learners and are keen to discover new things. So at some time during their school careers something seems to happen that obstructs this curiosity and impedes their willingness to learn within traditional school structures and subject areas. And as dropping out of school is an active way of showing disaffection, the number of early school leavers may just be the tip of the iceberg.

Evidence from international surveys (PISA, TIMSS and PIRLS) shows that family background, for example parental education, parental occupation, family structure or migrant background, are factors which significantly influence the achievement of pupils in schools in the EU. However, there is also evidence that some education and training systems manage to counteract such factors and thereby positively influence pupil performance. Surveys also indicate that over a third of the variation in pupil performance is attributable to differences between schools. This shows that the quality of the context (school, class, teaching) in which pupils are educated has a bearing on their progress, especially that of the weakest pupils.<sup>3</sup>

Disaffection is not just a problem with teenagers; it can start in the early years. It is also not just a problem for state schools. Independent schools are more able to select or reject children and young people and their cooperation with the parents is often more distinctive than at state schools. They are better able to respond individually and help more directly in cases of disaffection. But independent schools also have to deal with this problem and they too are searching for ways to support children and young people in crisis and to avoid early school leaving.

The *effe*-Colloquium will concentrate on how school should be organised to give pupils the best chance - regardless of family or migration background - of maintaining their natural interest in learning. The Colloquium will follow the progression of compulsory education, reflecting on the

Furthermore, research indicates that the distribution of effective contexts is not a matter of chance: in practice, working-class pupils find their way into the least effective schools/contexts, Duru-Bellat, M. (2004), social inequality at school and educational policies.



#### following questions:

- At what point do some children stop being eager to learn and why?
- How can curiosity be developed so as to encourage the child to become a lifelong learner
- o Are teachers and schools prepared in the best way to foster children's natural curiosity?
- o What kinds of changes do schools need to make?

The aim of the colloquium is to provide an opportunity for people who are active within education to meet policy makers and vice versa. Through a "market of possibilities" where everyone can discuss their thoughts and visions on this theme we want to ensure a vibrant exchange of ideas.

Furthermore, preliminary to the Colloquium the effe will set up a sms-project "pupil day X in Europe" at the beginning of March. The idea is to involve young people from across Europe in taking part in this conference through the medium of mobile telephones by reporting on one normal school day in Europe from their point of view. This project will enable us to share their experiences, feelings and attitudes. It is not a scientific project, but we do hope for insights and stimuli – and who knows - even literary pleasure.

#### Your way to Foyer:

- By plane:
  - Up to four trains an hour connect the airport to the Brussels North, Brussels Central and Brussels Midi stations
- By train:
  - Brussel-Noord/Bruxelles-Nord and then walk (30 minutes) or take a bus. Hotel des
     Colonies is within walking distance of this station
  - Brussel-Centraal/Bruxelles-Centrale and then take Metro Line 1 (direction Koning Boudewijn/Roi Bauouin – Bizet
  - Brussel-Zuid/Bruxelles-Midi and then take Metro Line 2 (direction Simonis)
- By bus

The Hotel, Rue des Croisades/Kruisvaartenstraat 6-10 in 1210 Brussels, is located in a side street which leads directly to the Place Rogier. Follow the Avenue (Boulevard d'Anvers/Antwerpsesteenweg) in the direction of the great Basilica on the horizon. Cross the bridge over the canal and turn left. Turning to the left, take the second street, this is the Rue des Ateliers/Werkhuizenstraat. You will find the Foyer at the beginning of this street on the left. You can also walk this distance; it will take you about 25 minutes. Walk from the Place Rogier towards the great Basilica on the horizon.
